In the furtherance of our mission, Mifflinburg Presbyterian seeks to deliver outreach activities in areas such as human service, Christian education, and drawing people into worship opportunities. Wanting to be God's "hearts and hands," Mifflinburg Presbyterian is looking for a special individual to equip, empower, and lead our members in "catapulting" our mission outreach programs into our community. We are seeking a person who has the following qualifications:

1. Have a mature faith in Christ
2. Have a good testimony
3. Be yielded to God
4. Have a zealous love for God
5. Have a zealous love for the lost
6. Be self-motivated
7. Have a good work ethic
8. Have a working knowledge of the Word of God
9. Be able to lead and teach
10. Be ready to participate in the life of our church
11. Have excellent communication skills.

JOB DUTIES

1. Initially, this will be a 12-month commitment of 16 to 20 hours a week with the understanding there will be some evening and weekend responsibilities.
2. Liaise with the Pastor to ensure that the Community Outreach Coordinator's work is fully aligned with the "spiritual" portion of our church's overall programming.
3. Gather mission outreach ideas from the Session, as well as from members of the congregation, along with developing new innovative ideas.
4. Provide executive summary reports of outreach plans for Session approval.
5. Report status of activities and progress to the Session on a monthly basis.
6. Provide periodic updates to, and engage with the members of the congregation in initiating, conducting, and completing the Session-approved mission outreach ideas.
7. Evaluations by the Session will be held at 3 months, 6 months, and at 12 months.
8. Depending on how the community outreach program plays out, the position may expand, contract, or be eliminated in future years.

POSITION REPORTS TO

The Community Outreach Coordinator will be supervised by the lay Pastor, and is ultimately accountable to the Session Board.

OTHER DETAILS

1. As indicated above the position is part-time.
2. It is self employment with a competitive salary and mileage reimbursement.

We have no preconceived ideas as to the denomination or age of this person. We ask that you prayerfully consider our endeavor. This will not be a simple task, but it will be a fulfilling one.
