MISSION AND VISION

Founded in 2016, the Casa Materna project provides necessary medical services and education for low-resource mothers and babies in the rural region of San Juan La Laguna and nearby towns. Our goal is that all women in this region have an affordable, accessible and safe place to give birth to their babies and, consequently, reduce fetal and maternal mortality in the region.

OUR TEAM

We are an all-female team of nurses, midwives and health workers supported by a US doctor and Physician Assistant. Saving Mothers and the School of PowHER collaborate with the Casa Materna Project to provide vital skills to our team and educate local women and midwives about pregnancy and healthy childbirth.



SERVICES

We request a voluntary patient donation of \$6.50 as registration for our services that includes:

PRENATAL CARE

We offer monthly appointments to pregnant women and recommend a minimum of 4 visits. Care includes:





EDUCATION

With each visit at Casa Materna, we provide patient education on topics such as breastfeeding, family planning and women's health.

DELIVERIES

We attend **normal, low-risk deliveries** at Casa Materna 24/7 with certified midwives. We integrate Mayan customs with western medicine in our services.
